












HUNTING GUIDELINES

PROFESSIONAL HUNTERS, STAFF, SKINNERS & TRACKERS

Our team of dedicated, licensed and highly experienced Professional Hunters, trackers and skinners, will guide, assist and attempt to educate you every step of the way. Together, the team has guided clients armed with rifle and bow to more than 50 species of game. You will arrive as a client and you will leave as a friend, with memories that we will all treasure forever.

HUNTING VEHICLES

We utilize a fleet of new, well-maintained, fully equipped 4x4 hunting and utility vehicles. Our vehicles all have radio communication to keep in contact with the camp and each other.

SHOOTING RANGE

We have a very well equipped 150-yard shooting range that will insure that you will be able to zero your rifles properly and hassle free before you go in search of that dream trophy.

SHOT PLACEMENT

The majority of shots are taken between 100-200 yards. Below are pictures showing where bullet placement should be, depending on the angle at which the animal is standing. On the pictures you will notice a red circle, bullet placement anywhere within this circle will hit the lung/heart area, which will result in a quick death, your Professional guide will also educate you on what the best shot placement will be.

FIREARMS & AMMUNITION

1. FIREARMS

By law a minimum caliber of .375 is to be used to hunt any of the Big 5 (Lion, Leopard, Buffalo, Rhino and Elephant). A .375 is a versatile caliber and can be used on every plains game species as well. Very good soft nose ammunition is always recommended, but especially on Big Five species. As recommendation for all plains game species, calibers such as .300 Win mag, 338,7mm, 7mm, 30-06 and the like are best suited for African antelope.

2. SCOPE

Choose a good quality variable scope to use on your rifle, as a suggestion; 3x9 power is sufficient in Leupold/Zeiss make. Bring the rifle that you shoot best. We as Professional Hunters prefer good shot placement over and above any high power firearms.

3. AMMUNITION

Choice of bullet should be a swift A Frame, Woodleigh, Barnes X, Nosler partition or Hornady soft nose.











HUNTING GUIDELINES

GENERAL HUNTING RULES

1. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

No alcohol may be consumed before or during the hunt. Hunting will not be allowed if under the influence of alcohol. This is the sole discretion of management.

2. HUNTING ETHICS

Our professional hunters will ensure that they adhere to the highest ethics, allowing for a fair chase at all times.

3. SAFETY

Firearm safety should be considered first priority, your firearm must be unloaded at all times and only loaded on the instructions of the professional hunter. When driving please make sure that your firearm is unloaded and pointing down to the floor of the vehicle. Ensure that firearms are unloaded and magazines emptied before entering the camp.

4. WOUNDING OF ANIMALS

An animal is considered wounded if any blood is found, no matter how little. This animal is then considered to have been hit and therefore the client needs to pay for the animal in full. Care must be taken by the client that his/her shot placement is correct to ensure that you leave with all your trophies. Make sure you are comfortable when taking the shot.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. DO YOU HIRE RIFLES AND AMMUNITION IF I DON'T WANT TO BRING MY OWN RIFLE?

Yes, we do have rifles and ammunition for hire, ranging from calibers .270 to .375. Hiring fee is \$50 per day per rifle, and cost price for ammunition, about \$3 per round, depending on the caliber.

2. WHAT TROPHY SIZE ANIMALS CAN I EXPECT?

We maintain a high standard of the quality of animals we harvest, and will do our best to make sure you get a good trophy size animal.

3. WHAT DO GUIDES AND STAFF NORMALLY GET TIPPED?

This is just a guideline, you can tip whatever you feel comfortable with. Each client will have his own professional hunter, tracker/driver, skinner, cook and +/- 3 camp staff.

For your professional hunter you can work on between US\$50 and US\$200 per person per day. Trackers and skinners can be tipped around US\$10 per person per day, the cook can be tipped between US\$20 and US\$50 per day. As for the camp staff, between US\$5 and US\$15 per person per day.

4. IS A 7 DAY HUNT 7 FULL DAYS OF HUNTING, OR DOES THAT INCLUDE THE DAY OF ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE?

A 7 day hunt, excludes arrival and departure days. Therefore a 7 day hunt will be 9 days in Africa.

5. WHAT CAN MY WIFE DO IF SHE COMES ALONG?

It is always nice to relax on the deck at the lodge, that overlooks a waterhole, frequently visited by game. She can also join us in the field or be taken to the nearby cities and places of interest, there is always much to see and things to do. We can also arrange a spa day in camp where your wife can enjoy a relaxing massage or facial treatment.

6. DO WE EAT THE GAME WE SHOOT?

Yes we do. The game can be prepared in different and delicious ways, which will add to the experience of the hunt.

7. HOW DO I GET MY TROPHIES HOME?

We will provide you with a reliable reference to look after and ship your trophies home. During your stay with us we will take you to at least one local taxidermist, so that you can check the quality of their work. If you prefer to mount your trophies at home, our local taxidermist will dip and pack your trophies and organize that they get safely to your chosen taxidermist.

8. WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO GO ON A SAFAR!?

Our best months for hunting is from April through to the end of September; these are our cooler winter months, and we will not be getting much rain during this time, however we do hunt throughout the year. So the best time will be as soon as possible, when it suits you.







A lot of the Limpopo Valley is fairly flat thorn bush, but Stanley Pieterse Safaris is a little bit unusually in that it's in really hilly country with a lot of really big big rocky ridges. Stanley operates a small personal family operation, they've got a small number of chalets, so they cater to smaller groups and I tell you what, their camp is one of the nicest I have ever been in. They have a boma and a pool that overlooks a waterhole where you're gonna see game. Their own place is really beautiful, host a wide variety of species; Kudu, Eland, the little guys; Steenbuck all the way up to Buffalo, some great Buffalo right there on his property, and of course they have concessions all around the area, able to hunt literally the entire Limpopo Valley and on beyond, depending on the game you want, but Stanley is really a cut above in catering and service, their camp is just absolutely lovely, they offer wonderful personal service and they're more

than happy to arrange trips into Kruger and sightseeing trips around the country, before or after your safari. They do a really, really fine job and I tell you what, I really enjoyed seeing their Buffalo, they have some great bulls wandering around that country, some wonderful Kudu, good Eland, great Sable and really all the rest. Stanley and his wife do a really fine job of making their customers feel right at home and I tell you what, their place is truly a home away from home. Stanley Pieterse Safaris, they do a fantastic job and you know what, you look at little things that kind of enable you to judge the quality of an outfit, wait till you see their butchery where the meat is recovered, it is absolutely state of the art, so that everything is properly taken care of, man, Stanley Pieterse Safaris is a great place to go for small groups that want personal service. You're gonna love it!





TROPHY PROCESSING FACILITY

We pride ourselves in providing our clients with top quality trophy handling facilities. We will see to it that your trophies are skinned and processed in the correct manner, using the proper methods to ensure good taxidermy work. As soon as your trophy has been harvested and pictures taken, we will carefully load your trophy and transport it back to our processing facility. Here we will hoist your trophy from the vehicle and move it to the skinning area by means of a railing system. Our qualified skinner will see to it that your trophy is carefully processed. Each part of the trophy is then tagged with your details; name, surname and what part of the trophy it is. This ensures that there will not be any confusion as to what trophy belongs to which hunter.

After the meat has been moved inside our cold room and each trophy part has been properly tagged, the different parts undergo further processing. Firstly, the skins are subjected to a pickled bath to ensure all possible bacteria are killed. The skins are then moved to a salt pit, which extracts any excess moisture. After the skins has been in the salt for approximately two days, it is

then moved to our drying area to be spread out and hanged until it is 90% dried. This allows the skins to be neatly folded and stored on our packaging racks, ready to be shipped to our preferred local taxidermist.

The skulls are boiled to remove any excess flesh, taking care not to submerge the horns in the water. After the boiling process is complete our skinner takes care of any leftover pieces of fat or flesh. The skulls are then placed in the salt pit to remove any remaining moisture. When the entire process is complete the skulls are then stored on our packaging racks, ready to be shipped to our local taxidermist.

We will personally handle the paperwork needed to conduct the export of your trophies. You have two options available to choose from; your trophies can either be dispatched to our preferred local taxidermist for full taxidermy work or exported as "dip-and-pack" to your preferred taxidermist in your home country.
